Entry Level / Lateral Police Officer

Position performs all aspects of police duties. Requirements that must be met in order to be considered as a Lateral Police Officer include: DPSST Basic Police Certification or equivalent out of state certification (only state certifications recognized by Oregon DPSST will be considered - must provide proof of certification at time of application). Position requires a valid Oregon driver's license (or ability to obtain prior to appointment), high school graduate or GED, must be 21 years of age, a U.S. citizen, and no felony convictions. Prior to appointment, successful candidate must pass pre-employment testing and screening process. Position has full benefits package and several incentives including up to \$200/month for intermediate and advanced certificates and 5% enhancement after 7-years.
